



Dr. Paisan Ruamviboonsuk is a Clinical Professor and the Chairman of Department of Ophthalmology, College of Medicine, Rangsit University, Bangkok, Thailand. He is the Assistant Director for the Centers of Medical Excellence of Rajavithi Hospital, Bangkok, Thailand. He is the Scientific Secretary of Asia-Pacific Vitreo-Retina Society and a Council Member of Asia-Pacific Academy of Ophthalmology, Asia-Pacific Teleophthalmology Society, and Asia-Pacific Ocular Imaging Society.

He was the former President of the Royal College of Ophthalmologists of Thailand (2013-2016) and the former President of the Thai Retina Society (2011-2014).
