Stephen G. Schwartz, MD, MBA is Professor of Clinical Ophthalmology at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine and Medical Director of Bascom Palmer Eye Institute at Naples. Previously, he served as Assistant Professor of Ophthalmology and Residency Program Director at Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, VA.

He is an author or co-author on over 150 peer-reviewed publications, 40 chapters, and one textbook. He is a recipient of a Secretariat Award and a Senior Achievement Award from the American Academy of Ophthalmology; an Honor Award and a Service Award from the American Society of Retina Specialists; and the John R. Brayton, Jr., MD Leadership Award from the Florida Society of Ophthalmology.

Dr. Schwartz is a graduate of Cornell University, New York University School of Medicine, and Northwestern University's Kellogg School of Management. He completed residency training at New York University, fellowship training at Baylor College of Medicine, and the Leadership Development Program of the American Academy of Ophthalmology.
