**Professor Nicole Eter** is Chair and Medical Director of the Department of Ophthalmology at the University of Münster. She completed her specialist training in 1999 and worked as a senior physician in the Department of Ophthalmology at the University Hospital in Bonn. She obtained her "Habilitation" (postdoctorial academic degree) in 2002 and became Professor of Ophthalmology in 2007. In 2010, Professor Eter was appointed Department Chair and Medical Director in Münster.

Her core competence lies in vitreoretinal surgery and medical retina, besides covering the entire range of anterior segment surgical procedures.
